PHIL'S BEACH

We are excited to announce the opening of Phil's Beach!

Our soft opening will take place on Wednesday, July 8, 2020. In adhering to guidelines set by CDC and IDPH, our capacity will be limited to 100 users, at this time (capacity updated 7-13-2020). Entry will be on a first come, first serve basis. Patrons will not be able to reserve spots for additional family members or friends not with them at the time of entry. Patrons must practice physical distancing requirements. Due to Covid-19, the facility does not have any water amenities (inflatables, rafts) in swim area. Due to our shortened season, the District has adjusted Daily Use Fees, and will not be selling season passes this year.

Amenities include: Splash Pad, Bathhouse, Gazebo, Bagger Boards, Game Tables, Rinse Stations, Swim Area, and Concessions (limited menu at this time).

Prohibited in the facility: Alcohol, glass containers, smoking, and pets.

Our infamous J-slide will be on site for nostalgia sake and photo ops but will not be in the water.

A Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting Event will take place in the future.

Hours of operation:	Monday – Sunday	11:00 am – 7:00 pm (weather dependent)
Daily Fees:	\$5 Resident / \$7 Non-Resident (must show proof of residency at gate)	
Twilight Fees (after 5 pm):	\$2 Resident / \$3 Non-Resident Seniors 62+ and children 3 years and under are free	
Parking:	Parking lot located across street; limited spaces available. Additional parking available at Wauconda Park District's Fest lot. Patrons will need to display daily permit in vehicle.	
Our 2020 Summer Season:	July 8-August 9, 2020 Weekends only – August 15-September 7, 2020	

Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older.

RULES

- 1. NO PUSHING ON RAFTS.**
- 2. NO HANGING ON BOUY LINES.**
- 3. NO SWIMMING UNDER RAFTS OR SLIDES.**
- 4. NO THROWING SAND OR STONES.**
- 5. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 13 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PERSON 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.**
- 6. NO RUNNING ON RAFTS.**
- 7. DO NOT DISTRACT LIFEGUARDS WHILE THEY ARE ON DUTY.**
- 8. NO CLIMBING ON LIFEGUARD STANDS.**
- 9. SITTING POSITION ONLY ON SLIDES.**
- 10. NO DIVING.**
- 11. STAY WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BOUY LINES.**
- 12. FLOATING DEVICES MUST STAY WITHIN THE FIRST BOUY LINE AND OFF ALL RAFTS.**
- 13. FRONT CRAWL STROKE MUST BE DEMONSTRATED TO SWIM PAST THE FIRST BOUY LINE.**
- 14. NO GLASS OR ALCOHOL ON THE PREMESIS.**
- 15. NO SMOKING ON THE PREMESIS.**
- 16. SWIMMING ONLY PERMITTED WHEN A LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY.**
- 17. WAUCONDA PARK DISTRICT IS NOT LIABLE FOR PERSONAL ITEMS FROM USERS INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE BEACH FACILITY.**
- 18. LIFEGUARDS MAY REMOVE ANYONE FROM THE BEACH FACILITY FOR ENDANGERING THEMSELVES OR OTHERS AT ANYTIME.**
- 19. PETS PROHIBITED ON PREMESIS.**
- 20. NO FEEDING OF THE WILDLIFE.**

REGULATIONS

- Beach water is not suitable for drinking. Avoid swallowing beach water.
- Admission to the beach may be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, diarrhea, vomiting, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages, or other bandages of any kind may also be refused admittance.
- A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the beach area.
- Littering is prohibited. In addition, no food, drink, gum or tobacco is allowed in the water. Glass containers are prohibited throughout the beach area.
- All children who are not toilet trained shall wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants.
- No one should swim alone.
- Persons under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older unless a lifeguard is present.
- Personal conduct within the beach must be such that safety is not jeopardized.
- Diving in shallow water is not permitted.
- Caution shall be exercised in the use of diving facilities.
- Swimming is prohibited after sunset or before sunrise, or when lightning is present, including a 15-minute period after the last lightning is observed.
- No pets are permitted in the beach area.
- Feeding wildlife or other actions that encourage their presence is prohibited.
- Patrons are encouraged to protect themselves from sun exposure.
